A 2024 HIMSS survey showed **55 percent of healthcare organizations boosted cybersecurity budgets, yet 74 percent still struggle to recruit or keep cyber talent**-a gap that widens every time a senior analyst burns out. 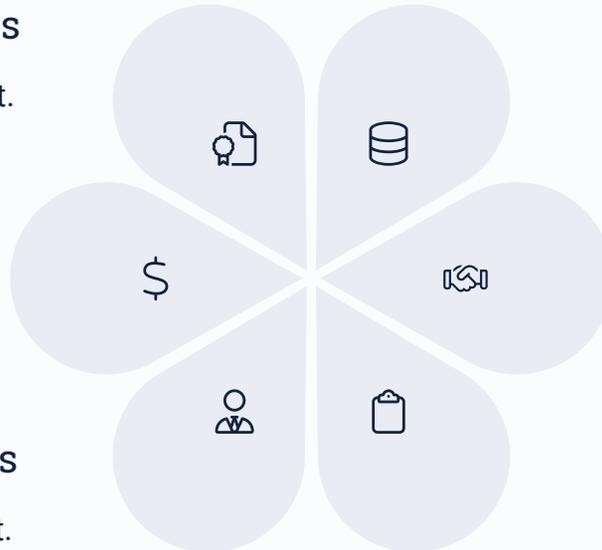
